- To introduce participants to the interface between disability and safeguarding.
- To recognise ways in which disabled children can be more vulnerable to harm.

- 2. Have recognition of the perceived barriers to communicating with disabled children.
- 3. Understand the impact of values on safeguarding disabled children.
- 4. Understand indicators of abuse and neglect, including subtle signs across the diverse range of disabilities, and vulnerabilities of disabled children.
- 5. Have increased knowledge and confidence in seeking support in your role and an awareness of where to get that support.
- 6. Understand the issues faced by parents of disabled children and be confident to improve partnership with parents.
